## 5. Landstrom Proposal (Glebe Field) – Diocese Land adjacent to Birdingbury Recreation Ground

Following a lengthy discussion in which all Councillors took part it was agreed: -

- The Parish Council does not wish to engage via any steering group with regards to the potential development.
- As the proposed development is outside the Parish Boundary it is contrary to the Local Plan.
- This information needs to be shared with the village in a neutral fashion.
- **6.** The Clerk is to write to Landstrom to advise them of the Parish Council's position as shown at point 5.

# 7. New entrance into the recreation ground.

Cllrs Morton and Preston and the Clerk had a virtual meeting with Warwickshire County Council Road Safety team regarding making a new entrance into the recreation ground at the top of the hill, so people using the field can access it using the footpath as opposed to walking up the grass hill. WCC have confirmed this is acceptable. WCC will supply a barrier opposite the new entrance as a safety measure.

It was proposed by Cllr Morton, seconded by Cllr Preston and **RESOLVED** a new entrance will be installed into the recreation ground.
